

How to Make Your Garage Doors Last Longer

Preventive maintenance is the key

Making your doors last longer doesn't mean you take it upon yourself to conduct repairs. Door parts are extremely sensitive to tension, so tinkering around with your garage door not only harms the door, but you as well. Preventive maintenance is more about knowing how to properly use the garage door and knowing what to do when something is up.

For this, it is important to read the manual. Yes, most homeowners never read the manual that comes with their garage doors. However, all doors are different, and some may require special care that's detailed in the manufacturer's instructions. If you easily get bored reading manuals, remember to ask our garage door repair technician for tips the next time he comes around.

Preventive maintenance is different from DIY repair projects, but can help a lot in prolonging the lifespan of the door. Regular lubrication with WD-40 on the springs and tracks can prevent rust and jamming. There are also several diagnostic tests you can perform on the automatic opener system to check if it is still in working condition without having to touch or mess around with the other parts.

Handle with care

Although garage doors are sturdy, you should remember that they are exposed to harsh weather elements every day. Coupled with daily wear and tear, the door takes a beating daily, and the best thing you can do is to lessen the burden. Always treat the door with care. Use the door only when needed, and never leave it open for a long time.

If you have kids in the house, remind them never to play with the garage doors. Never give them the remote for the automatic opener system. If you are using manual doors, don't force it open or close if it seems jammed or broken. Call our professional instead. If there is anything in the door system that doesn't work the way it's supposed to, don't use force – it will only

make the problem bigger.

If you have an automatic opener system and you are going on a vacation, remember to turn it off. Just like humans, garage doors need regular care from a professional. Don't just call in a technician when there's trouble. It's a good idea to get the doors checked especially after harsh conditions, like winter or after a huge storm or hurricane.
